




(upside would be not having to remove ring)

I wanted to make additional parts to the ring that would likely be magnetic, and its purpose would be to allow for the wearer to freely put on the parts that would surround the ring, with a hole formed by the two parts when they connect, where another piece can be placed into that hole, and that piece would have 10 holes in it, each hole for a petal shaped piece of metal (was imagining gold petals) to be placed inside. In order for all these pieces to be relatively secured, I was imagining it would be possible with magnetism. on the following page you can see how I was loosely imagining it would putting it together:



This is what I want to be the core of the ring, 4 bands in one: gold (preferably 24k), green stone (thinking Peridot'cause it's one of my fiance's birthstones), Opal (my birthstone), and gold again. Gold would have an engraving on the outside, design something like the examples below:



the style on the other gold band should be matching whatever style is used











This is a 24k gold band, size 6, represented as a straight 3-dimensional figure for the sake of showing the design, but this would be a ring. the figure is approximate, to give an idea of what I'm looking for. the stones I would like would be Opal, Peridot, and not sure what would be good for the black one (maybe onyx, obsidian, I'm open to suggestions). the engraving in the ring does not need to be exactly as depicted above, the idea is that it is sort of like that the flowers are interconnected, and that coming from them are leaves.
